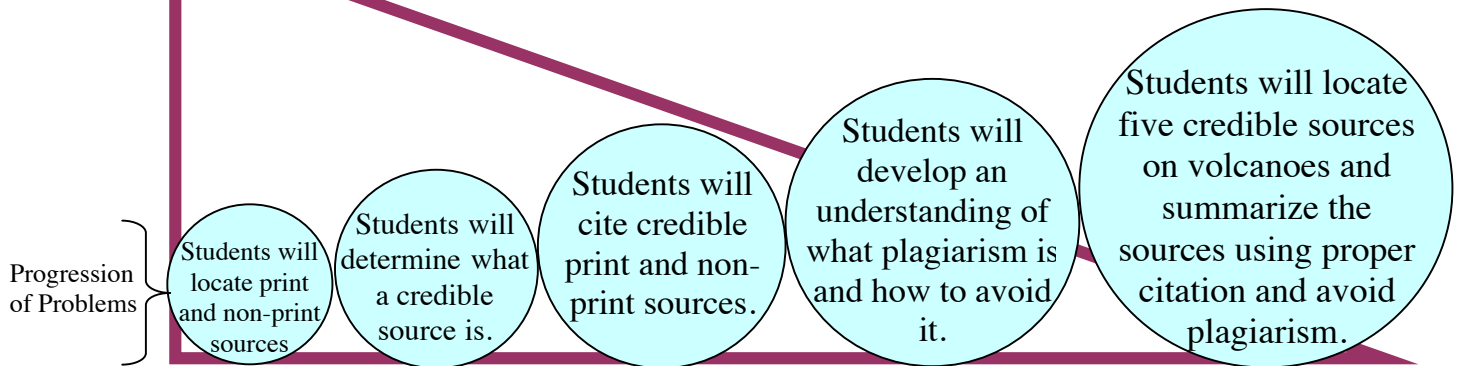
PITP Project Graphic Organizer
